The State Department has provided the following information to AILA liaison:

“Earlier this week the Bureau of Consular Affairs in Washington experienced a number of computer and communication problems which collectively have created a processing backlog of one day's worth of IV and NIV cases (approximately 40,000). We are taking steps which we expect will return processing to normal by this weekend. We are expediting emergency cases but many other individual cases are delayed two or three days.”
