E-Verify launched Records and Information for Department of Motor Vehicles for E-Verify (RIDE) in June. RIDE strengthens the integrity of E-Verify by adding driver's license verification. Mississippi is the first state to partner with DHS for the RIDE program and, so far, more than 25,000 driver's licenses have been validated.
